Additional Information about the Family Child Care Training

The Seattle Department of Education and Early Learning will provide professional development for family child care providers to improve outcomes for all children. Family Child Care Training participants will receive:

- 20 hours of HighScope Family Child Care training conducted by a certified HighScope trainer.
- MERIT/STARS credit for up to 20 hours.
- A small payment or stipend of \$30 per class to offset the cost of attending the training. (Maximum \$300.00 per series.)*
- A completion bonus of \$150.00 for completing all 10 courses in a 20-hour series. (Three series of 10 courses (Units 1 – 30) will be available in all, pending future budget approval by the City Council.**
- Translation/Interpretation services are available upon request.***
- Up to two hours of on-site coaching each month.

* Stipend and bonus are paid out after successful completion of the series training, and will not exceed the annual maximum of \$450.00 per participant per series.

** The first training series is in 2017. The second and third HighScope training series are expected to be held in 2018 and 2019, subject to future budget approval by the City Council.
