Levy-Funded Key Strategies

- Seattle Parks and Recreation Community Learning Center provides extended day and extended year academic and enrichment activities as well as break camps
- Communities in Schools and City Year offer case management and family outreach to increase attendance and engagement
- In-House Academy, a program that offers alternatives to out-of-school suspension
- Somali-Speaking Youth Service Assistant provides academic and emotional support to students and families to promote attendance and targeted interventions
- El Centro de la Raza and University Tutors offers academic tutoring during and after school
- Expanded learning opportunities throughout the day--additional math classes offered for struggling students and extended literacy classes for all students
- School based health center services focus on treating and preventing health issues that interfere with academic achievement, including immunizations, chronic disease management, reproductive health care, oral health, and behavioral health counseling.
- Denny operates on-site summer learning program to provide additional academic and enrichment opportunities
