Levy-Funded Key Strategies

- High School Graduation Success Coordinator works with students, families, and teachers to identify barriers and develop action plans to improve grades and earn credits
- Career Center Specialist provides intensified case management support to students identified with significant barriers to post-secondary success.
- YMCA implements after-school enrichment and service activities and support a caseload of focus students
- Asian Counseling and Referral Service Care Coordinator will provide behavioral health care screening and care coordination to 9th graders
- University Tutors provides academic tutoring for focus students
- 9th grade counselor provides and manages social/emotional support services for 9th graders and their families
- Parent Coordinator works to maximize 9th grade parent involvement
- Additional case management support for College Bound Scholars experiencing significant academic and social/emotional barriers
- School based health center services focus on treating and preventing health issues that interfere with academic achievement, including immunizations, chronic disease management, reproductive health care, oral health, and behavioral health counseling
