# School Based RFI Application Submission

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- Instructions to applicants (page 14)
- Deadline 5pm 12/13 Electronic or paper submissions accepted
- You will be sent notification of receipt (*reduce anxiety about whether app got in on time*)
- Technical compliance review
- Use templates provided; mindful of page limits; etc.
