- Must put a new (unused) wheelchair accessible vehicle into service (the County and City will contribute a combined total of up to \$5,000 per year toward this expense for up to 5 years)

Requirements



WAT Certification

Proposers must have WAT certification or an equivalent certification and the ability to obtain WAT certification if awarded.

25 Points



Driving Record

Proposers must meet or exceed the at-fault collision and moving violation 150 Points standards. Points are deducted for each incident in the past 5 years.



Conduct Record

Proposers must meet or exceed code violation and passenger complaint standards. Points are deducted for each incident in the past 5 years.

175 Points



Experience

Points are awarded based on the number of years of experience the Proposer has as a taxi, for-hire, or TNC licensed/permitted driver and transporting individuals using mobility devices.
