

NEW STUDY SHOWS THAT MUSIC STREAMING SERVICES REDUCE ILLEGAL DOWNLOADS

FIVETHIRTYEIGHT

A study by Economists Joel Waldfogel and Luis Aguiar compared the growth of Spotify streaming to the weekly volumes of torrents for 8,000 top artists, using data from Musicmetric, a music analytics company. Every additional 47 streams displaced one pirated download.
