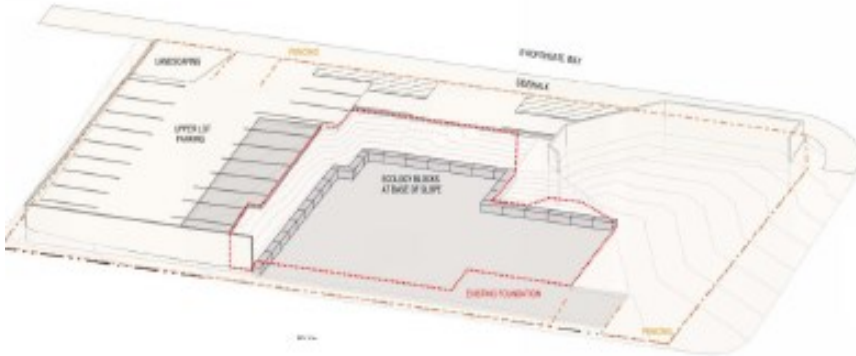

ABOUT THE PROJECT:

In October 2019, the Seattle Fire Department, together with FAS and the Mayor's Office, determined that the existing Fire Station 31 no longer met the needs of this growing sector of the City. A replacement station, designed to meet current operational standards, will be built several blocks to the northeast of this existing station (webpage link). No longer needed for fire operations, the City will demolish the existing structure.

INTERIM STATION LOCATION

During the design and construction of the replacement Fire Station 31, the firefighters will work out of an interim station, that will be located across the street from the existing building, at 10503 Interlake Avenue North (webpage link). The interim station is scheduled to be operational in July 2021. Fire Station 31 units are currently responding from adjacent neighborhood stations until the interim station is constructed.
