Permit Conditions

Ceremonial Use of Grounded Fireworks (Outdoors)

This permit including attachments must be posted near the occupancy/activities and/or be available for inspection by any public official.

1. Receipts for fireworks purchased under this permit must be attached to this permit.
2. This permit is valid only on the date, time and location of the discharge listed on the application.
3. This permit is valid only for the quantity and type of fireworks listed on the application.
4. No aerial display, rockets, missiles or the like are allowed.
5. Fireworks may only be purchased from a Washington State Licensed Fireworks Wholesaler. A list of licensed wholesalers is available at: www.wsp.wa.gov/fire/docs/fwlicensing/licwhole.pdf
6. Permit holder is authorized to purchase only the fireworks listed in the application that will be discharged under this permit.
7. No storage of fireworks is allowed beyond 3 days prior to the date of discharge.
8. If you have unused fireworks, you are to return them to a Washington State Licensed Fireworks Wholesaler or to the nearest Seattle Police Department Precinct no later than 3 days after the date on the permit.
9. A competent adult (minimum age 18 years) must directly supervise the event.
10. At least two pressurized water, Class 2-A extinguishers and two Class 10-BC extinguishers shall be provided, within 25 feet of where fireworks are used. The extinguishers shall be placed so that at least one is located on each opposing side of the performance.
11. Spectators must be separated from the fireworks being fired by a minimum of 15 feet. There shall be no glowing or flaming particles within 10 feet of the audience.
12. The area where fireworks are being fired must be completely free of combustible materials for a distance of 25 feet.
13. Motor vehicles must be a minimum of 25 feet from the area of discharge.

14. Fireworks being fired must be separated a minimum of 25 feet from any building or structure.
15. During dry periods, the area where fireworks are being fired must be wet down prior to discharge.
