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Utility Discount Program Fast Track Application Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Utility Discount Program?

The Utility Discount Program is a City of Seattle program that provides income-qualified customers with a 60% discount on their Seattle City Light (City Light) bill and a 50% discount on their Seattle Public Utilities combined utilities bill.

Do I need to provide supporting documentation when I enroll?

For this limited opportunity to use the fast track application, you do not need to provide any supporting documentation. You only need to fill out the form provided to you. **We may request supporting income documentation at a later point in time to verify eligibility.**

How much can I expect to save on my utility bills if I enroll in Utility Discount Program?

Customer savings averaged approximately \$1,200 per year in 2018.

How do I apply?

Just complete your application according to the instructions on the form. If you need help completing the form or need interpretation services, please call the City of Seattle Utility Discount Program at (206)684-0268 between 7:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to speak with a specialized agent who would be happy to assist you.

How will I know when I am enrolled in the program?

In 4 to 6 weeks your City Light bill will include your electric discount and your Seattle Public Utility bill will include your combined Utilities discount. The discount will be noted as "Utility Discount Program Savings" on your next bill after enrollment.

If you live in a multi-family building that is served by Seattle Public Utility, but don't pay a water bill directly, you will find your Seattle Public Utility discount included as credits on your City Light bill.

What counts as household gross monthly income?

*Gross monthly income is the total amount of money all adults 18 years and older in your household earn in a month before taxes.
