Dear Ballard Avenue Landmark District Residents, Property and Business Owners:

The building in which you live or work, or which you own, is in the Ballard Avenue Landmark District. This nationally recognized historic district was established in 1976 to commemorate the neighborhood's unique place in Ballard's history. To preserve its special character, the Ballard Avenue Landmark District Board reviews and approves all changes to building exteriors within the district before the changes are made, such as signs, awnings, window transparency, paint colors, street furniture and new construction.

The Board has seven members, including five that are elected and two that are appointed by the Mayor. The Board meets at 9:00 a.m. on the first Thursday of each month at the Ballard Neighborhood Service Center, 5604 22nd Ave NW. The meetings are open to the public and community members are encouraged to attend. ELECTION NOTICE

An election for two seats on the Ballard Avenue Landmark District Board will be held on Thursday June 14 from 2:00 to 7:00 p.m. at 5337 Ballard Ave NW. The open positions are for a property owner or businessperson, and a property owner. Absentee voting is available and will take place at the Ballard Customer Service Center prior to the election.

Residents, businesspersons and property owners within the district are eligible to vote in the election and to run for a Board position. Advance registration and nomination are required.

Nominations must be delivered to 5337 Ballard Ave NW. Candidates for Position 1 must be District property or businesspersons. Candidates for Position 2 must be District property owners. Candidates for Position 3 must be either a resident or tenant within the district.

Friday June 8 starting at 3:00 p.m. through noon Thursday, June 14.

Ballots may be picked up in person at the Neighborhood Service Center. You will be asked to sign for your ballot. Absentee ballots must be returned to the Customer Service Center by **noon, June 14.**
