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ORDINANCE 110352

- AN ORDINANCE relating to historic preservation, imposing controls upon the New Age Christian Church, a Landmark designated by the Landmarks Preservation Board under Chapter 25.12 of the Seattle Municipal Code (Ordinance 106348).
- WHEREAS, the Landmarks Ordinance, Chapter 25.12 of the Seattle Municipal Code (Ordinance 106348), establishes a procedure for the designation and preservation of structures and areas having historical, cultural, architectural, engineering or geographic importance; and
- WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Board after a public hearing on July 16, 1980, voted to approve the nomination of the New Age Christian Church at 1763 Northwest 62nd Street in Seattle as a Landmark under Code Chapter 25.12; and
- WHEREAS, after a public hearing on August 20, 1980, the Board voted to approve the designation of the New Age Christian Church as a Landmark under Code Chapter 25.12; and
- WHEREAS, the Board and the owners of the designated property have agreed to controls and incentives; and
- WHEREAS, the Board recommends to the City Council approval Now, Therefore, of controls and incentives;
- BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Board of the New Age Christian Church, more particularly described as: Lots 2 and 3, Block 20, Gilman Park, as a Landmark based upon satisfaction of the following criteria of Code Section 25.12.350:

- It embodies the distinctive visible character-1. istics of an architectural style, or period, or of a method of construction; and
- Because of its prominence of spatial location, 2. contrasts of siting, age, or scale, it is an easily identifiable visual feature of its neighborhood or the city and contributes to the distinctive quality or identity of such neighborhood or the city;

is hereby acknowledged.

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Section 2. The following controls upon alteration of the landmark are hereby imposed;

A Certificate of Approval must be obtained or the time for denying a Certificate of Approval must have expired before the owner may make alterations or significant changes:

- where such changes would affect the exterior of l. the structure, including changes in paint colors and surface materials; and
- where such changes would require a City construc-2. tion permit and would also affect that portion of the site northward from a line extended east and west from the back wall of the original church structure;
- provided that no Certificate of Approval shall be 3. required for replacement of existing glazing with stained glass and all in-kind maintenance and repair of the above noted features shall be excluded from the Certificate of Approval requirement.

Nothing herein shall prevent any changes in such features where such changes are necessitated by changes in the liturgy, it being understood that the church is the exclusive authority on liturgy and is the decisive party in determining what architectural changes are appropriate to the liturgy.

Section 3. The following incentives are hereby noted as potentially available to the owner although the listing shall not be construed as all inclusive:

As a part of Code Section 24.74.020 - Special Exceptions of the City Zoning Ordinance certain incentives are available, on an application basis, to permit, in

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certain circumstances, uses not otherwise permitted within the zone in which the Landmark is located.

Section 4. Enforcement of this Ordinance and penalties for its violation shall be as provided in Code Section 25.12.910.

Section 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to record this ordinance with the King County Director of Records and Elections, deliver two copies to the City Historic Preservation Officer, 400 Yesler Building, and deliver one copy to the Director of the Department of Construction and Land Use.
