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Foster School Existing Facilities

- Bank of America Executive Center
 - Constructed 1997
 - Executive MBA Programs
 - Classrooms, Offices, Lounge Space
- Foster Business Library
 - Constructed 1997
 - Underground Structure connected to other Foster Buildings
 - Serves faculty, researcher and students from entire campus
- PACCAR Hall
 - Constructed 2010
 - 250 Seat Auditorium, Classrooms, Meeting Spaces, Cafe

Foster School Existing Facilities

- Dempsey Hall
 - Constructed 2012
 - Office of the Dean, Offices, MBA & Undergraduate Career Centers, Buerk Center for Entrepreneurship, Classrooms, Executive Forum
- Mackenzie Hall
 - Constructed in 1960
 - Houses three Foster School Centers, Foster School Advancement and Alumni teams, Minority Business Hall of Fame, Offices



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Foster School Expansion Project Goals

- Continue success in attracting the best faculty, students, and staff.
- Create space that is flexible and adaptable to meet the evolving needs of the Foster Business School
- Compliment the existing Foster School buildings to form a cohesive and connected Foster School complex
- Celebrate and enhance distinctive campus open space and circulation patterns in this part of campus.

Foster School Expansion Project Scope Summary

- Design and construct a new 96,000 square foot building to replace Mackenzie Hall.
- Program mix of instructional, academic and administrative spaces.
 - Classrooms
 - Offices
 - Team and Meeting Rooms
 - Workshop space
 - Large Common Areas
- Foster School PHD program, Center for Leadership and Strategic Thinking, and the Foster School Advancement and Alumni Teams.

Foster School Expansion Project Milestones

- Facility and Site Assessments
 - Mackenzie Hall Replacement Feasibility Study 2015
 - Mackenzie Hall Consolidated Audit 2017
 - UW Foster School Expansion Site Study 2018
- Landmarks Preservation Board Nomination March 2018
 - Board did not approve Landmark status
- UW Regents Stage 1 Approval April 2018
- Integrated D/B Team Selection April – July 2018
- Project Definition & Design August 2018 – December 2019
- Construction January 2020 – August 2021
