

# Your Voice, Your Choice: Parks & Streets

Projects are eligible for funding if they meet the following criteria:

- Benefits the public
- Is a physical or capital improvement project in Seattle's parks or streets
- Does not exceed \$90,000

## Examples of Eligible Street Improvement Projects:
