Key Program Strategies (Please provide a brief overview of program strategies including number of students served and program costs):

1. 1:1 Academic Intervention – Targeted one on one supplemental Reading or Math support. Research-based instructional program focuses on foundational skills. Program is aligned to the Common Core State Standards. Formative and Summative Assessments. Students meet with tutor 3x/week for 1hr. sessions. 30 hour program, October – June.
2. After School Expanded Learning Opportunities – Homework and supplemental support in Math and Reading. Groups meet 2/x week for 90 minute sessions. Supplemental support curriculum is research-based and aligned to the Common Core State Standards. Emphasis on building positive relationships and creating supportive environments. Formative and Summative Assessments. Small Groups, no more than 9:1 student to tutor ratio. 70 hour program, October – June.
3. Saturday ELL Tutoring – Weekly, 4hr. group sessions for English Language Learners. Program includes homework support and emphasizes Washington English Language Proficiency Standards. October – June
4. Maximum number of students for each program: 300

Results Achieved (Bullets or Brief Description):

- Assessment data shows overall improvement across all programs and grade levels is an average gain of 11.67% across all grade levels and an average grade equivalency improvement of 6.5 months
- Average student program attendance is 84%. 81% of students report fewer than 5 days of school absence per semester
- 92% of students with an emergent understanding of Tutoring Plan Academic Goals at the beginning of the program move beyond an emergent level of understanding by the conclusion of our program
