With U.S. citizenship, you can:

- Vote for your elected official.
- Become an elected official.
- Better help relatives become citizens.
- Apply for federal benefits.
- Apply for federal jobs.
- Receive retirement benefits.
- Receive full protection under the constitution.
- Live and travel outside the U.S.

The New Citizen Program can help you:

- Find out if you can apply.
- Apply for free.
- Request an age or disability waiver if eligible.
- With legal assistance and representation.
- Prepare for the interview.
