INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

The named employee was arrested for DUI in another state in 2012.

COMPLAINT

The complainant, a supervisor within the department, alleged that the named employee had violated the law and was being charged criminally in another state for DUI.

INVESTIGATION

The OPA investigation included the following actions:

- 1. Review of the complaint
- 2. Review of the police report and court documents
- 3. Search for and review of all relevant records and other evidence
- 4. Interviews of SPD employee

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

OPA waited for the other state to finish their criminal investigation before commencing their administrative review of this case. The named employee had violated the law and had committed the DUI in another state.

FINDINGS

The evidence showed that the named employee violated the law. Therefore a **Sustained** finding was issued for *Violation of Law*.
