


Seattle Region: Future Transportation System

- 1.5 Mile/\$53 M South Lake Union Line Opened December 2007
- 50% of Capital
 Funding from Local

 Improvement District
- 2008 Ridership 30%
 Above Forecast






Initial Segment—Construction Highlights

- Substantial Completion October 2007






Ridership Performance & Trends Average Daily Ridership by Month

 Mayor & City Council Endorsed 15-Mile Streetcar Network Development Plan in 2008

 Two Extensions/4.5 Miles Identified As Initial Priorities.









Priorities for Expansion

 2-mile First Hill Line connects Light Rail system to Medical Center. Fully funded through regional transit measure (\$120M).










Priorities for Expansion

- \$135 M



First Hill Streetcar Background & Purpose

Replaces First Hill Light Rail Station

Funded as Part of ST2 Ballot Measure

 Primary purpose is to connect light rail trips from the north and south the healthcare oriented jobs and services of First Hill






