






Dedicated private property from ArenaCo parcel to the north to the S. Massachusetts ROW to enable the realignment of the street.

- Facilitate the property transfer with survey, land use and legal transactions






Existing 1st Ave S & S Massachusetts St // Looking East




A shared use street is proposed from
1st Ave. to Occidental Ave. S. and aligns
with the recently proposed Street Design
Concept Plan. The intersection with 1st Ave.
will also be realigned and a portion of S.
Massachusetts St. to the east of 1st Ave. will
also be improved.

- Approximately 16,800 sf of improved ROW for shared use street
- Concrete paving with finishes similar to adjacent plaza open space
- Use of non-standard site amenities such as benches, lighting and bike racks
- Approximately 6,500 of improved ROW to the west of 1st Ave. S.
- Curb bulbs at each corner of the intersection













Per the 1st Ave. Street Design Concept Plan, the existing parking lane on the east side of 1st Ave. S. will be improved as additional sidewalk, planting and site amenities. Two black frontages will be improved from S. Holgate St. to Edgar Martinez Drive.


Description

A comprehensive re-design of Holgate Ave. to increase pedestrian safety and facilitate freight mobility. Improvements include the realignment of S. Holgate St. from 1st Ave. S. to 4th Ave. S., sidewalks and a pedestrian bridge that accommodates bikes.

- 136,700 sf of roadway improvements
- 1,200 lf of sidewalk
- 860 lf 12' wide pedestrian bridge with elevator and direct and secured connection to the arena.

Work with a recognized artist to develop an art plan to be implemented with the project after the selection of artist(s)

- Art Plan that identifies a set of art opportunities throughout the site
- Opportunities may include but are not limited to the pedestrian bridge, the open space plaza and ROW street frontages.







The project proposes to treat all of its waste with an ecological sewage treatment facility called a Living Machine. A portion of the Living Machine will be located in the open space plaza for display and interpretation. Treated water will be re-used in the building for toilet flushing and landscape irrigation.

Proposed Public Benefits

- 99% Reduction in Wastewater
- Removing 4 Million Gallons of Sewer each year from the overflowing Combined Sewer System (Not required by code)
- Water capture and re-use water
- District Opportunity as the Reclaimed Water System is scalable to serve parcels to the North
- Educational / Interpretative signage



Provide bicycle connections to the west and east of the arena site. Utilize a combination of in=street and off-street facilities to provide safe and direct access.


- 1,700 LF of bike infrastructure along S. Atlantic Ave., S. Utah St. and S. Massachusetts St. from the existing waterfront trail






