Let's Work on ...

- Puget Blvd. Park is underused. Playground doesn't get used. Need play features for kids under 8 years old.
- Puget Blvd Park: "Use-less" park. Children's equipment –
 no one knows how to use it. Becoming a hangout for loiterers.
- People have been working on restoration along the greenbelt
- 26th Ave SW: Our cars have been hit due to speeding cars traffic calming
- Delridge Way: Cars parked too close to the corners; obstructs view; can't see when turning left (Delridge Community Center)
- Delridge Community Center: Crosswalk, but dangerous
- Delridge Way: make it a more pleasant walking environment.
