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7	WHEREAS, in 2009, the City Council approved resolution 31147 expressing support for entering into a new interlocal agreement with King County to establish a rural transfer of development rights program and identifying South Lake Union as a potential receiving area for the use of additional development rights; and

10	WHEREAS, in 2011, the State enacted legislation allowing the creation of Landscape Conservation and Local Infrastructure Programs (LCLIP) providing for financing for infrastructure in neighborhoods designated to be receiving areas for regional developmen rights; and	
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13	WHEREAS, in 2013, the City Council approved Ordinance 124172 rezoning portions of the South Lake Union Urban Contar and adopting development standards for the South L	
14	South Lake Union Urban Center and adopting development standards for the South Lake Union Urban Center and certain zones in the Downtown Urban Center that would be implemented if a Landscape Conservation and Local Infrastructure Program were formed; and	
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16	WHEREAS, the City of Seattle has consulted with King County and the Washington Departme

24	adopted as the plan for developing public infrastructure under RCW 39.108 for the proposed	
25	Local Infrastructure Project Area for Downtown and South Lake Union.
