SEATTLE HUMAN RESOURCES 2022 EXAMINATION BIBLIOGRAPHY FOR BATTALION CHIEF

The exam application filing dates will be January 3-19, 2022. The written examination for Battalion Chief will tentatively be held on Friday, April 1, 2022, at a location to be determined.

NOTE: Reference material issued after December 30, 2021, will NOT be included on the written examination.

Candidates who pass the written examination will be scheduled for the oral board portion of the examination (assessment center), tentatively scheduled for June 13 - 18, 2022. Candidates may be required attend more than one day during this period. Candidates must attend all portions of the Oral Board/Assessment Center to be placed on the Register. The assessment center examination exercises will be based on the 1) skills and abilities identified by the job analysis as critical for successful job performance as a Battalion Chief, 2) information from the Promotion Development Committee who serve as subject matter experts, and 3) reading materials in the bibliography.

All examination dates, times, and locations are tentative and may be changed in compliance with the current COVID-19 public health guidelines.
