

Project Summary:

The purpose of the project is to restore the old play area site to a natural condition as part of the contiguous greenbelt supporting wildlife habitat.

The project involves removing the last pieces of the play area – a slide & stairway, retaining walls & foundations – stabilizing the slope and replanting with native species.



12th Ave W & W Howe St Park -Ariel View - DCI

The park is located within the SW Queen Anne Greenbelt and within designated critical areas for slope, soil landslides, and wildlife habitat.

Habitat Restoration: Fall 2019 or Spring 2020






