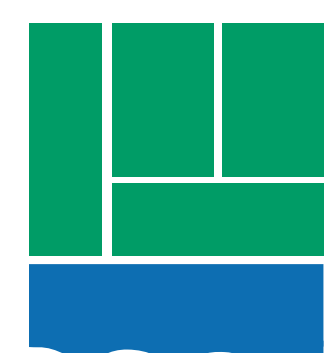
1. Create a schematic design for a new racket court at Lowman Beach Park.

4. Minimize disturbance to existing park features.

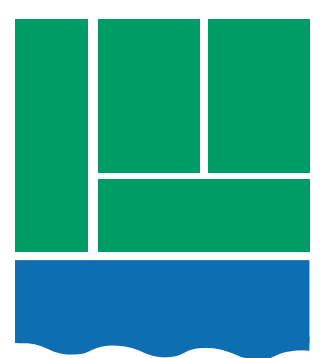
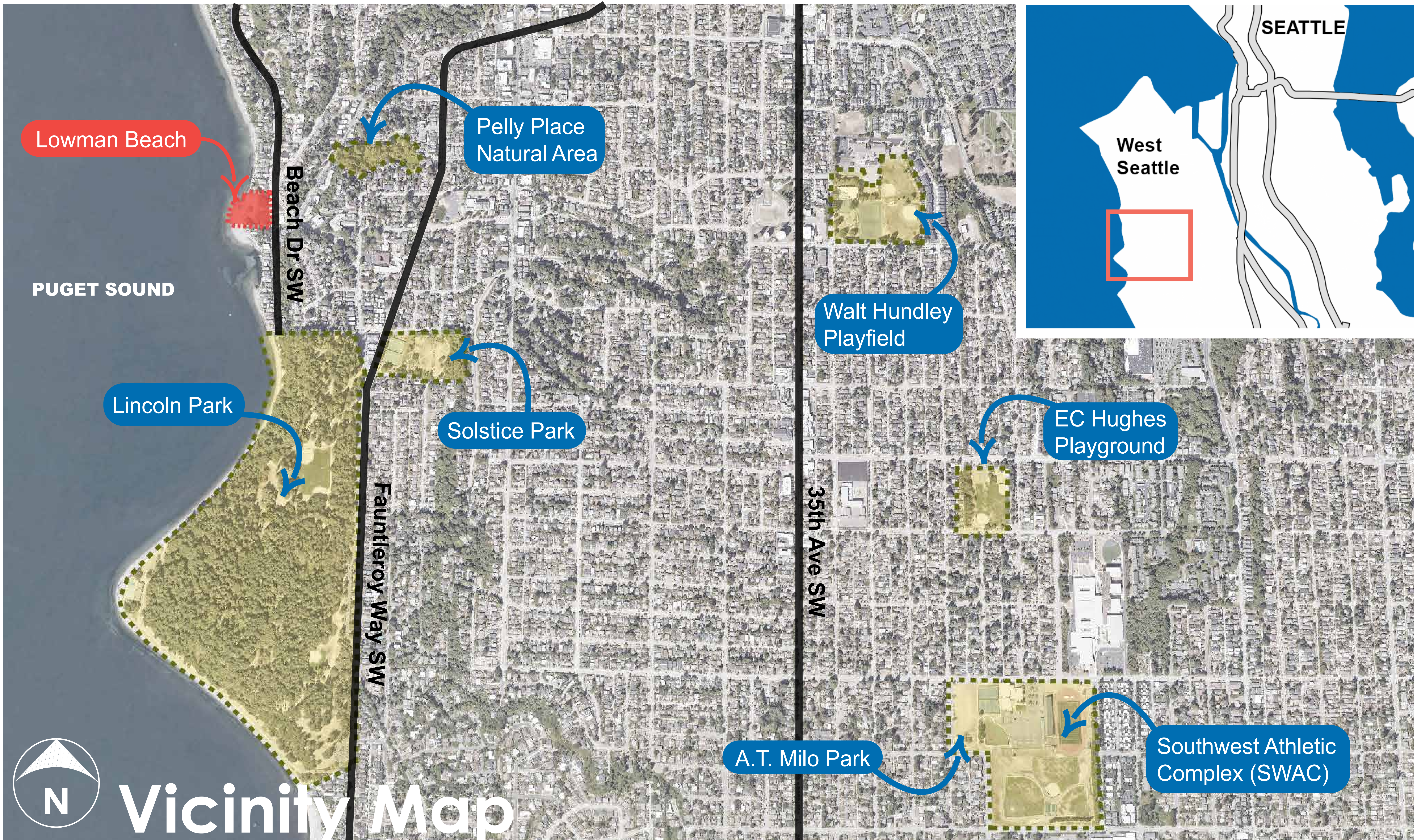

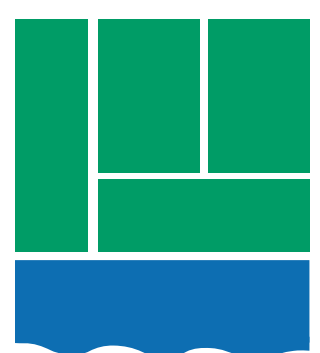
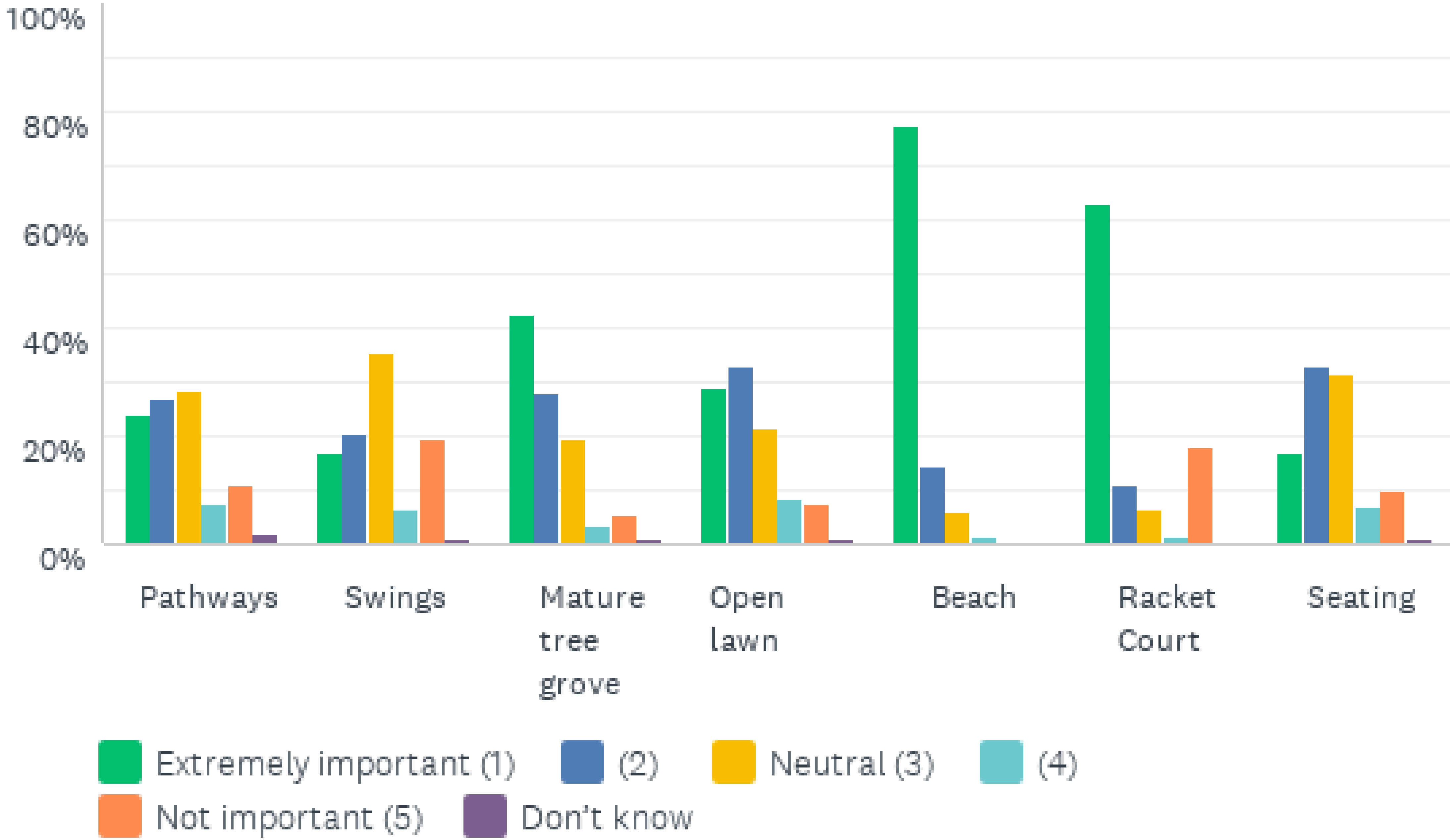
What We Heard: Existing Features

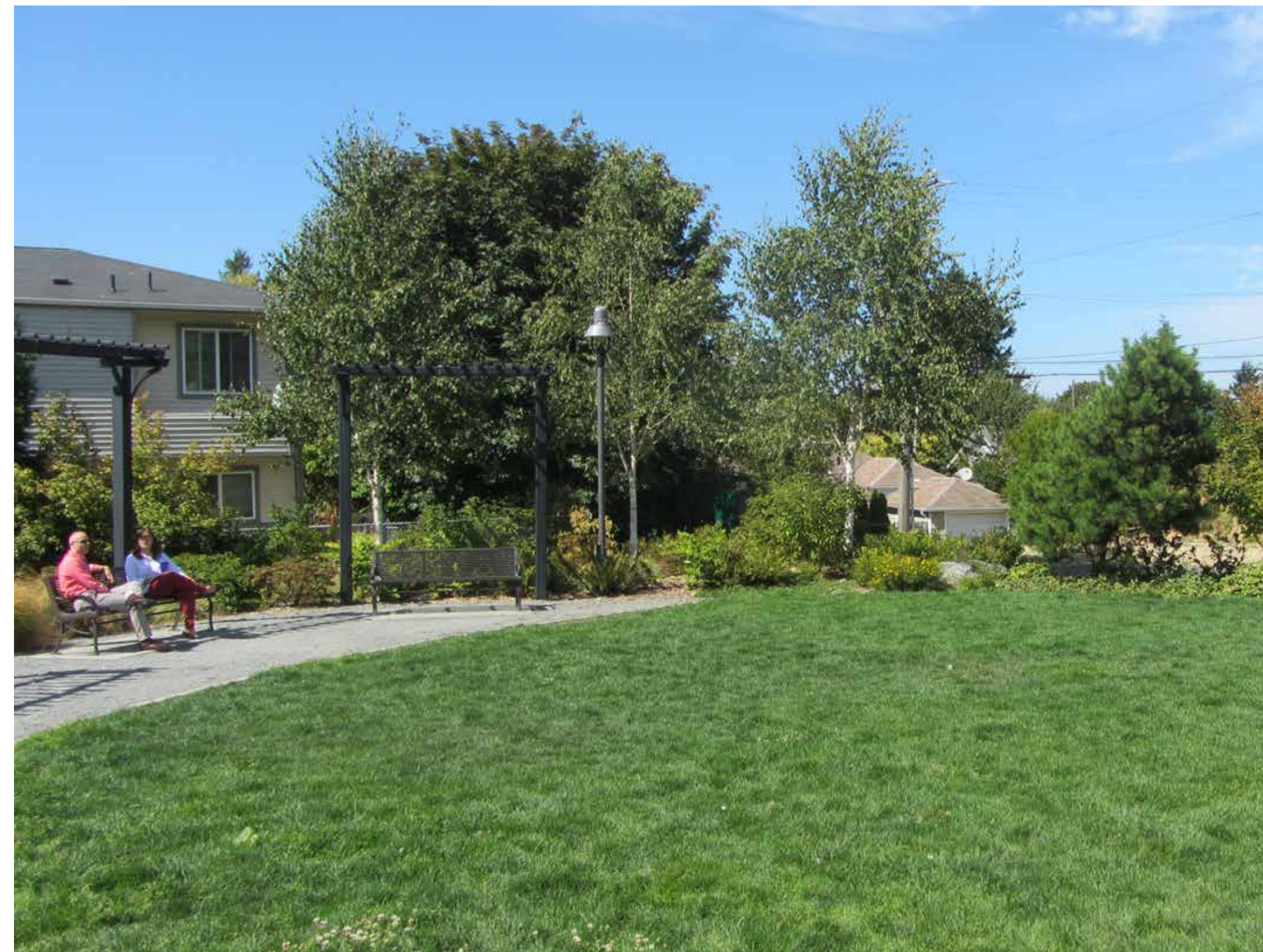

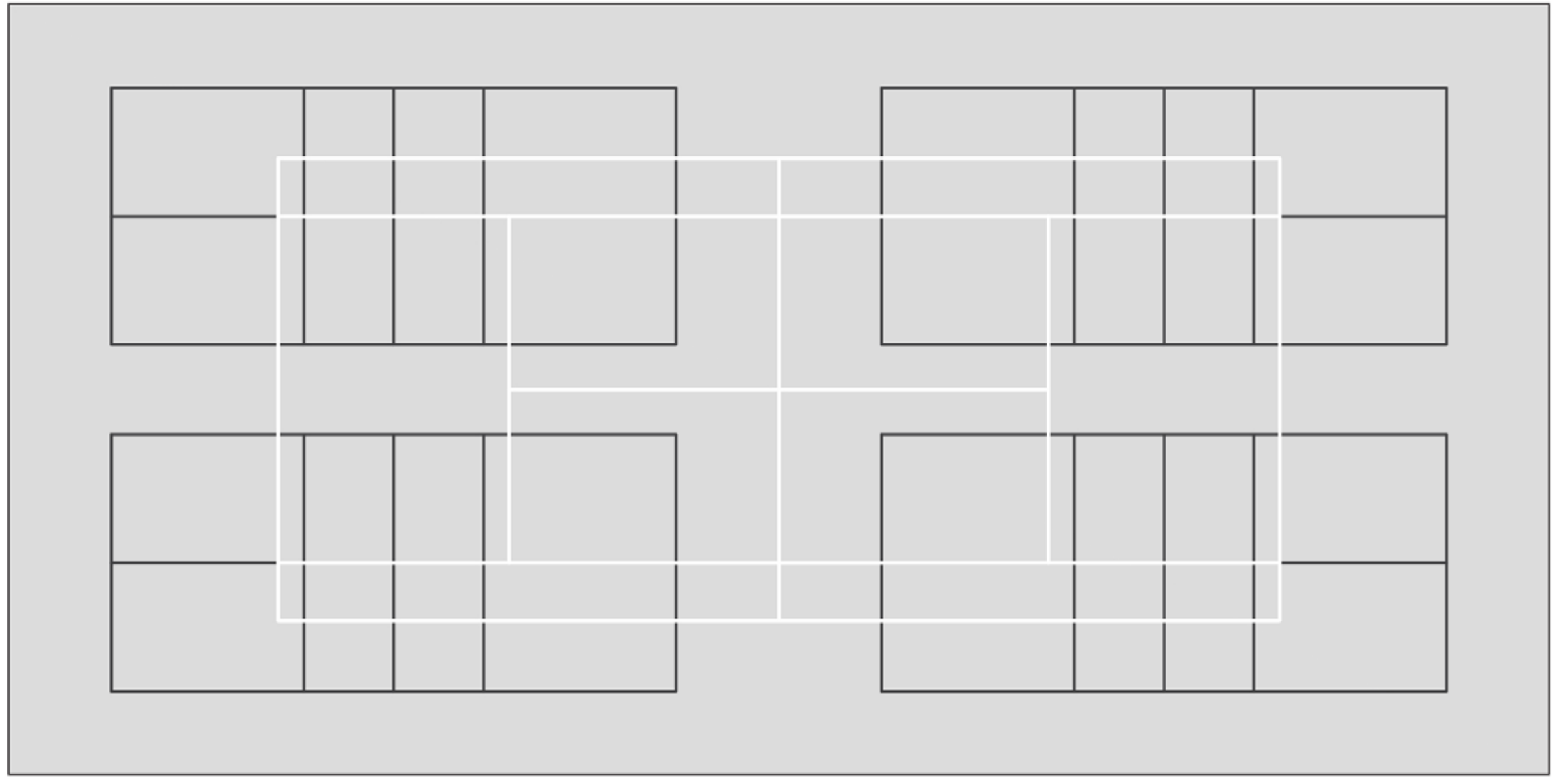
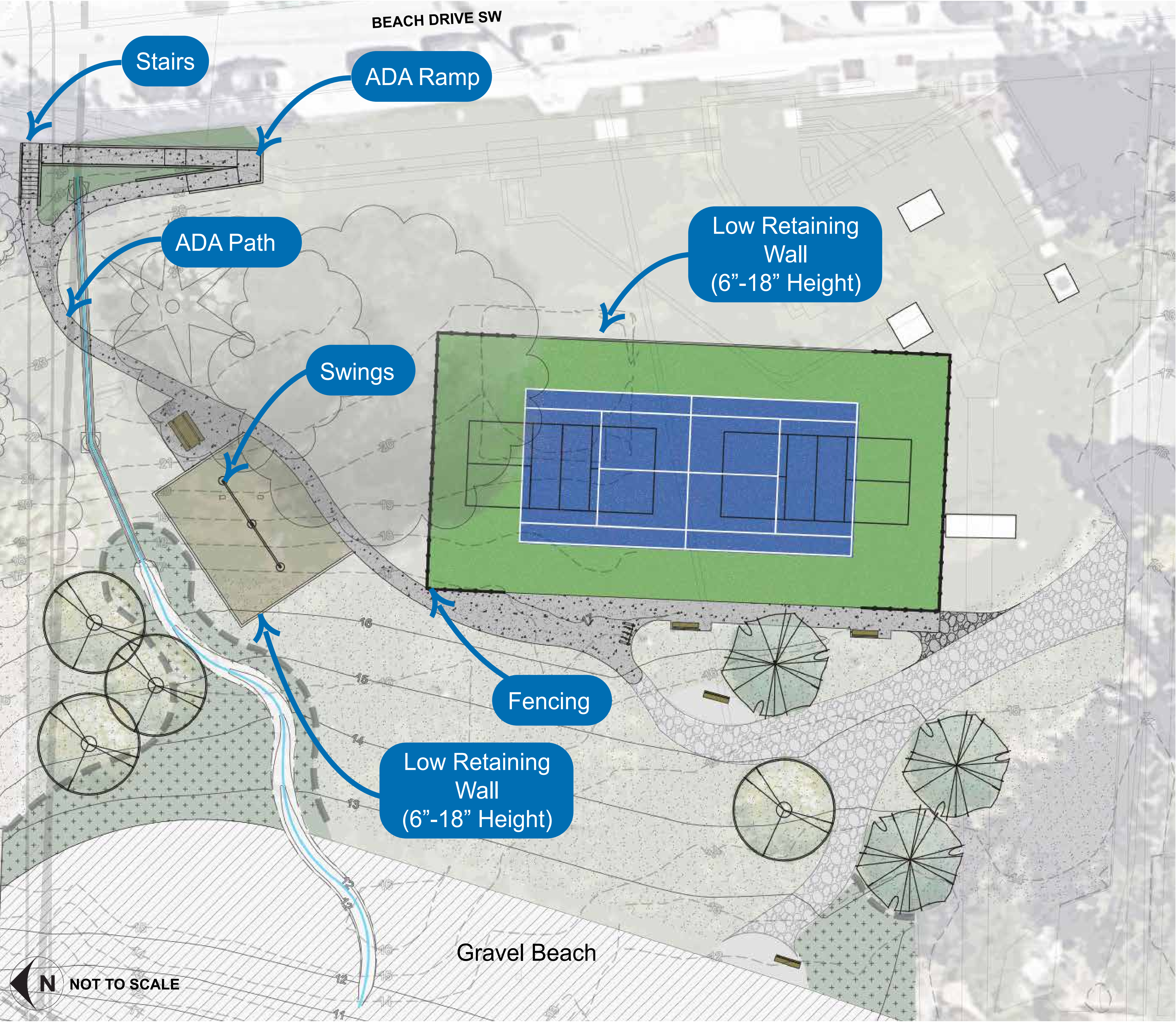


What We Heard: Park Amenities

Concept 1: Full Size Multi-Sport Court

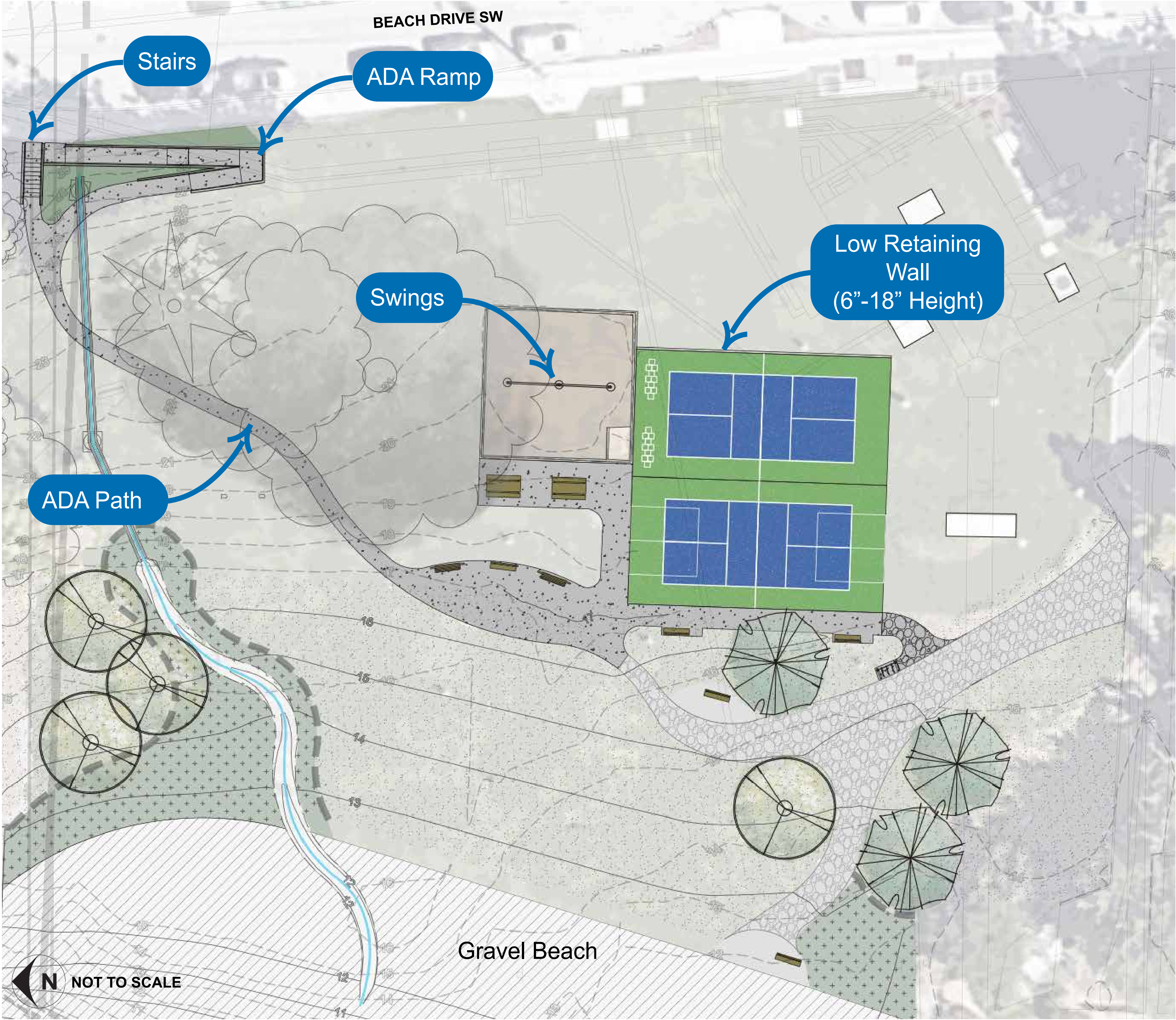



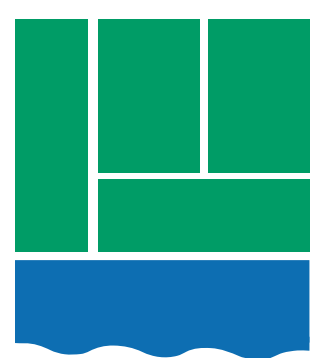

Concept 2A: Medium Size Court + Swings

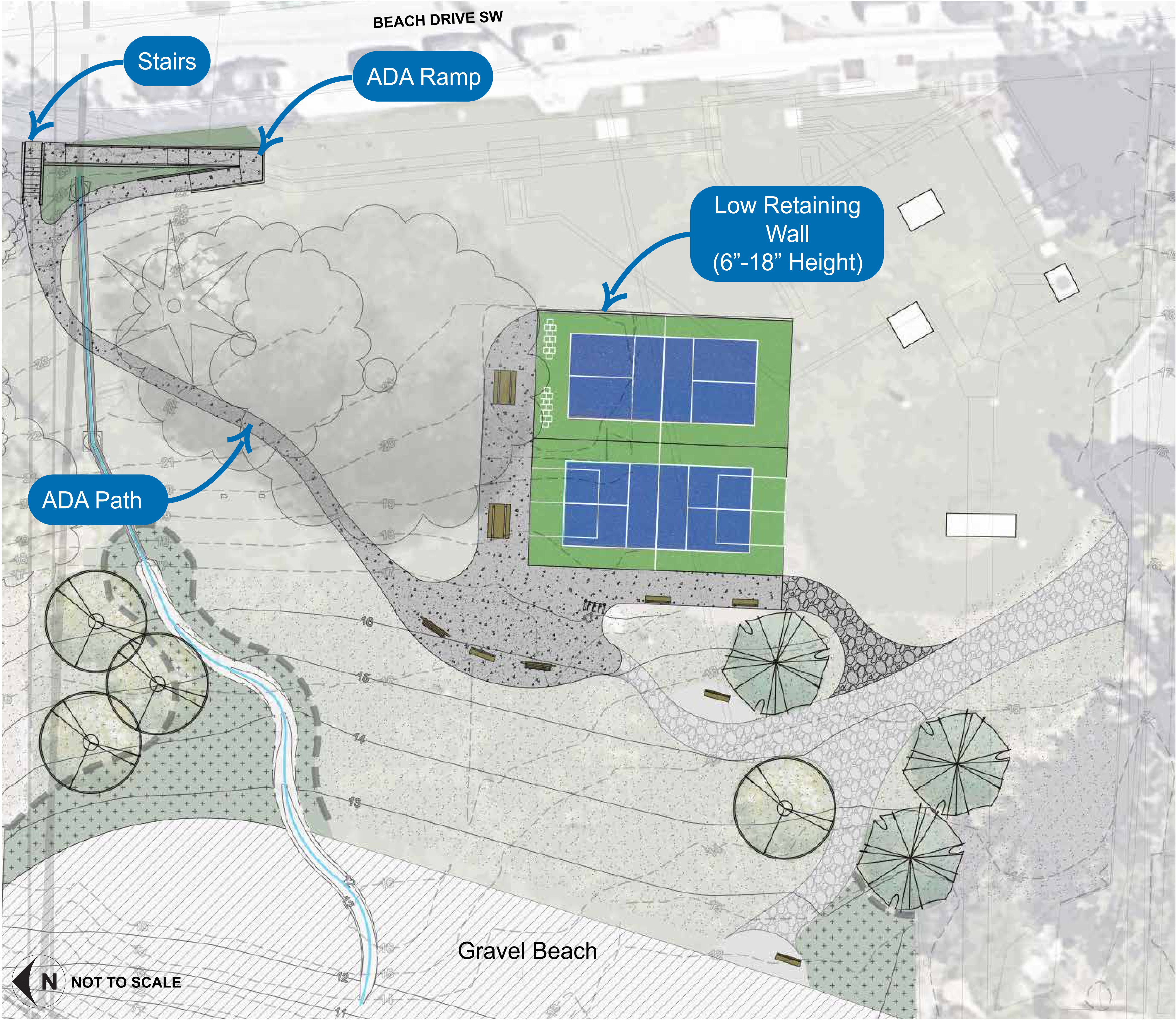



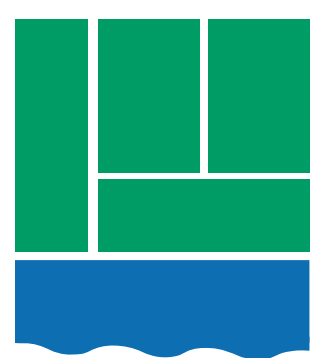


Concept 2B: Medium Size Court + No Swings

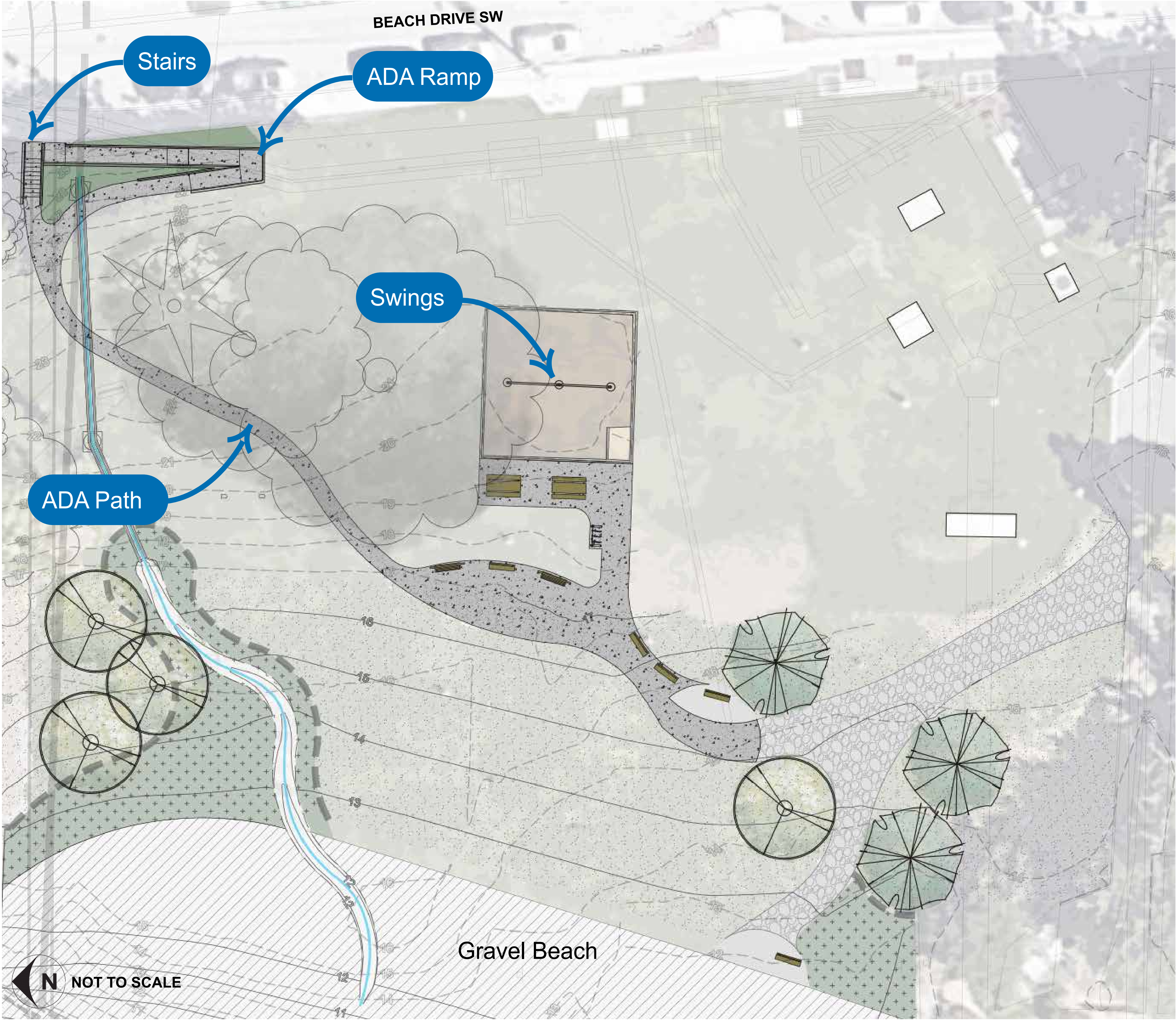



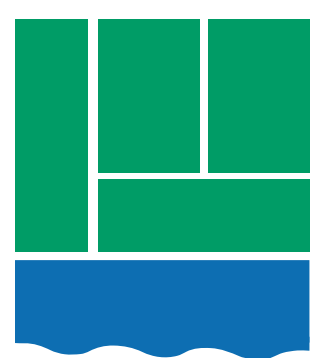
