Scope

Resurface existing synthetic multi-purpose sports field and make necessary accessibility improvements related to drinking fountain and restroom access.

Schedule

Planning: Spring 2018 – Winter 2018
Design: Winter 2018 – Summer 2019
Construction: Summer 2019 – Spring 2020

Budget

Planning/Design/Construction: \$2,385,000

Construction Contract: \$1,477,500

Funding Source Real Estate Excise Tax



Project Scope

- Remove existing synthetic turf (approximately 130,000 square feet in size)
- Inspect and repair existing gravel leveling base and field drainage, as necessary
- Install new synthetic turf system (meet recreation and Association for Testing Materials (ASTM) standards for impact attenuation)
- Include layout and lining for multiple sports; No change to lights or field use restrictions
- Retrofit travel routes ADA standards, including:
 - Connections from the field to the exterior restrooms, as necessary
 - Replacing drinking fountains
 - Other accessible improvements related to the playfield, as needed and budget allows




What We Heard
