

New Member Self-Service (MSS) Portal

This Summer and Fall, SCERS is rolling out its new Member Self Service (MSS) Portal. **SCERS is** rolling out this service to our members in scheduled waves. You will not be able to register through the portal until you have received your notification from SCERS.

The MSS Portal will allow active and retired members to securely access their City of Seattle retirement (pension) plan information on-line, from anywhere. The MSS Portal replaces Retiree Self-Service for our retired members and Employee-Self Service (for retirement information only) for our active members.

With MSS, active and retired members will be able to:

- View account information at any time.
- View your SCERS contributions or pension benefit.
- Ensure your information is correct and up to date.
- Send a secure message to SCERS staff.
- Active members will also be able to create a benefit estimate using a simplified calculator tool.

Please be aware that cybercrime is on the rise. If you receive communication from SCERS that you are unsure about, contact our office at <u>retirecity@seattle.gov</u> so we can verify the information. **SCERS** does not need to request information from you before sending your notification to register.

Once you have received notification from SCERS, you will have the information you need to register for MSS.
