BURKE-GILMAN TRAIL MISSING LINK What is an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)?



The State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) helps decision-makers and the public understand how a proposal will affect the environment through a process to identify probable environmental impacts that may result from governmental decisions.


State and local agencies are required by SEPA to consider the likely environmental consequences before a proposed project is approved, denied or modified to reduce likely impacts.

The EIS for the Burke-Gilman Trail Missing Link will:

- Evaluate Build Alternatives to complete the Missing Link and compare them to a No Build Alternative
- Describe and document the environmental studies conducted for the project
- Describe potential adverse impacts and whether those impacts would be significant
- Describe mitigation measures proposed to reduce the potential adverse impacts






BURKE-GILMAN TRAIL MISSING LINK Map of Alternatives










Leading Concerns Raised in the Comment Letters
