

CENTRAL RIDGE NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY Selected Route

FACT SHEET

PROJECT OVERVIEW

We're building a neighborhood greenway on 18th Ave from S Weller St to E Republican St, and on 16th Ave E from E Republican St to Volunteer Park. We plan to construct the southern portion (phase 1 - from S Weller St to E Columbia St) as soon as this year. Neighborhood greenways are safer, calmer residential streets for you, your family, and neighbors. We make people walking and biking the priority.

Neighborhood greenways can include:

- Easier crossings of busy streets with crosswalks, flashing beacons, or traffic signals
- Speed humps to calm traffic
- Stop signs for side streets
- 20 mph speed limit signs
- Signs and pavement markings to help people find their way

WHAT WE HEARD

Last summer, we asked people in the Capitol Hill, First Hill, Central Area, and Judkins Park communities for their feedback on the most promising route for this neighborhood greenway. We heard general support for the route and are moving forward with it as our selected route.

The selected route features minor updates that incorporate past community feedback, including:

- A new traffic signal at 18th Ave to help people walking and biking cross Madison St (to be installed in coordination with the future RapidRide G line project on Madison St)
- An upgraded traffic signal and new right-turn only sign for northbound drivers at 18th Ave and S Jackson St
- An extension of the south end of the neighborhood greenway to S Weller St and 20th Pl S to connect directly with the Central Park Trail and the future King St Neighborhood Greenway
- Coordinating with the adjacent hospital project on 18th Ave between E Cherry St and E Jefferson St to install new curb bulbs, speed humps, green bike boxes, and improved crossings

SELECTED ROUTE

Phase 1 - south end

In the south end, our route will start on S Weller St at 20th Pl S. We'll then transition to 18th Ave heading north. This will connect people to the International District via a future east-west neighborhood greenway and points south via the Central Park Trail. We'll also get people to Swedish Cherry Hill and several schools along the route.

Anticipated construction date: Late 2018

Phase 2 - north end

In the north, we'll keep the route on 18th Ave and then transition it to 16th Ave E at E Republican St to get people closer to the heart of the 15th Ave E business district. The route will end at Volunteer Park via E Prospect St.

Anticipated construction date: Phase 2 schedule will be coordinated with the RapidRide G line project on Madison St.
