What's a neighborhood greenway?

Neighborhood greenways are safer, calmer residential streets for you, your family, and neighbors.

We make people walking and biking the priority on residential streets.

Neighborhood greenways can include:

- 20 mph speed limit signs
- speed humps to calm traffic
- stop signs for side streets crossing the neighborhood greenway
- signs and pavement markings to help people find their way
- easier crossings of busy streets with crosswalks, flashing beacons, or traffic signals

MOST PROMISING ROUTE

We've been working with community members from Capitol Hill, First Hill, Central Area, and Judkins Park since winter 2017 to identify routes for a new north-south neighborhood greenway to be built in 2019.






CENTRAL RIDGE NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY Most Promising Route
