



2021 Slurry Seal Project

We will slurry seal your street as soon as Monday, August 30th; expect a 1-day road closure

OVERVIEW

As soon as Monday, August 30th, we will begin slurry sealing your street. You will see NO PARKING signs go up 3 days prior to when you need to have your car moved off the road. At that time, you will receive a notice for the exact date of the work.

Slurry Sealing is a 1-day process (about 8 hours) where a mixture of asphalt and aggregate is applied to the road. This protective seal coat will extend the life of the pavement.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- On the day of the slurry seal, you will not be able to drive, park, or walk on the new road surface for up to 8 hours. **If cars are still parked on the street when the crews show up to work, cars will be towed.**
- If you live on a street with no sidewalks, the slurry seal only goes to the edge of the street. You should plan to use an alternate way around your neighborhood the day of the work.
- The day we slurry seal, you'll see, hear, and experience construction activity. This means workers staging and communicating with each other in the early morning hours. Large trucks and machinery coming, going, and operating. Noise, dust, and possible vibrations.
