

HARBOR AVE SW & SW SPOKANE ST INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

FACT SHEET

March 2018

PROJECT BACKGROUND

This spring, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will improve safety for people walking, biking and driving at the intersection of Harbor Ave SW and SW Spokane St in West Seattle. In 2016, the Harbor Ave SW and SW Spokane St Intersection project was one of 12 selected by the Levy to Move Seattle Oversight Committee to be funded through SDOT's Neighborhood Street Fund (NSF) program. The NSF program funds projects requested by the community.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Adding a curb bulb to increase space to stand and visibility at the northeast corner
- Adding a signal to give people biking a protected crossing from the northeast to the southwest corner of the intersection
- Removing segments of a jersey barrier along the Alki
 Trail approaching Harbor Ave SW
- Restriping the crosswalk
- Trimming overgrown landscaping on the northeast corner
- Adding a bike ramp on SW Avalon Way


Maintaining transit and freight access to Harbor Ave SW and SW Avalon Way is a key element of the project. Adding the protected bike signal will increase wait times at this intersection during some peak times of the day.

PROJECT BENEFITS

- Increased visibility of and safety for people walking and biking across Harbor Ave SW and SW Spokane St
- Basic signs and markings clarifying when motorists can make left turn onto SW Avalon Way

- We've finalized project design
- We expect construction will begin as soon as mid-May
- You can expect typical construction impacts such as dust, noise, and truck activity
- We'll follow up with adjacent neighbors in advance of construction


