



Greenwood Ave N Paving and Pedestrian Safety Project Update

WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW?

As early as July 9, crews will begin construction of a new sidewalk, planting strip, curb, and gutter on the east side of Greenwood Ave N. The first work area will be between N 137th St and N 138th St, with work progressing from south to north, toward N 145th St.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The contractor will maintain access to driveways within the work area between N 137th St and N 138th St.

Neighbors can expect noise from heavy construction equipment and activities, including concrete breaking, excavation, and concrete pours.

Signed pedestrian detours will be in place when construction prevents crews from maintaining a safe pedestrian path.

WORK SCHEDULE

The first phase of work, between N 137th St and N 138th St, is expected to last approximately three weeks. Work hours are between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. During construction, the contractor will close the northbound right lane of Greenwood Ave N, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3 p.m., to allow space for crews to work safely.
