WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW

Project Background

The segment of Greenwood between N 117th St and N 130th St in Broadview has been a longstanding priority for a new sidewalk construction- it is lined with homes, apartments, condominiums and businesses, while also being a frequently used bus route. We plan on installing new sidewalks along Greenwood Ave N between N 117th St and N 130th St. Construction is expected to start as early as spring 2021.

Benefits

- These new sidewalks will fill critical gaps and help connect residents to frequent transit services, schools, and other neighborhood destinations.
- With this project we plan to perform spot natural drainage treatments, which will enhance water quality and drainage in this area.
- These improvements will help achieve Seattle's Vision Zero goal to end all traffic deaths and serious injuries by 2030.

Schedule


WHAT WE'VE DONE
