VENDING PERMITS

The City of Seattle encourages street-food vending to increase public use, enjoyment, and safety of our public right-of-way. With proper design and management, street-food vending can be a great way to encourage walking, add vitality to the street, and promote local economic development.

PERMIT FEES

The table below summarizes vending fees by permit type. Review and inspection fees are billed according to the amount of time the review or inspection takes and are invoiced. All other fees are due at permit issuance.

Occupation Fee Table, Stadium, Sidewalk, and Plaza Vending

The occupation fee for stadium and event center, sidewalk and plaza vending permits are calculated by the square footage of the vending site and by the location of vending per the table below.
