Each spring for the past decade, students in public elementary and K-8 schools across the city have participated in a two-day classroom survey on how they travel to and from school.

In June of 2015, **43** schools and over **13,000** students participated in this survey.

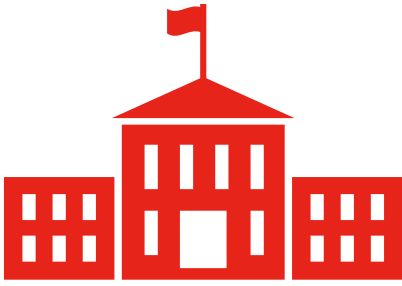

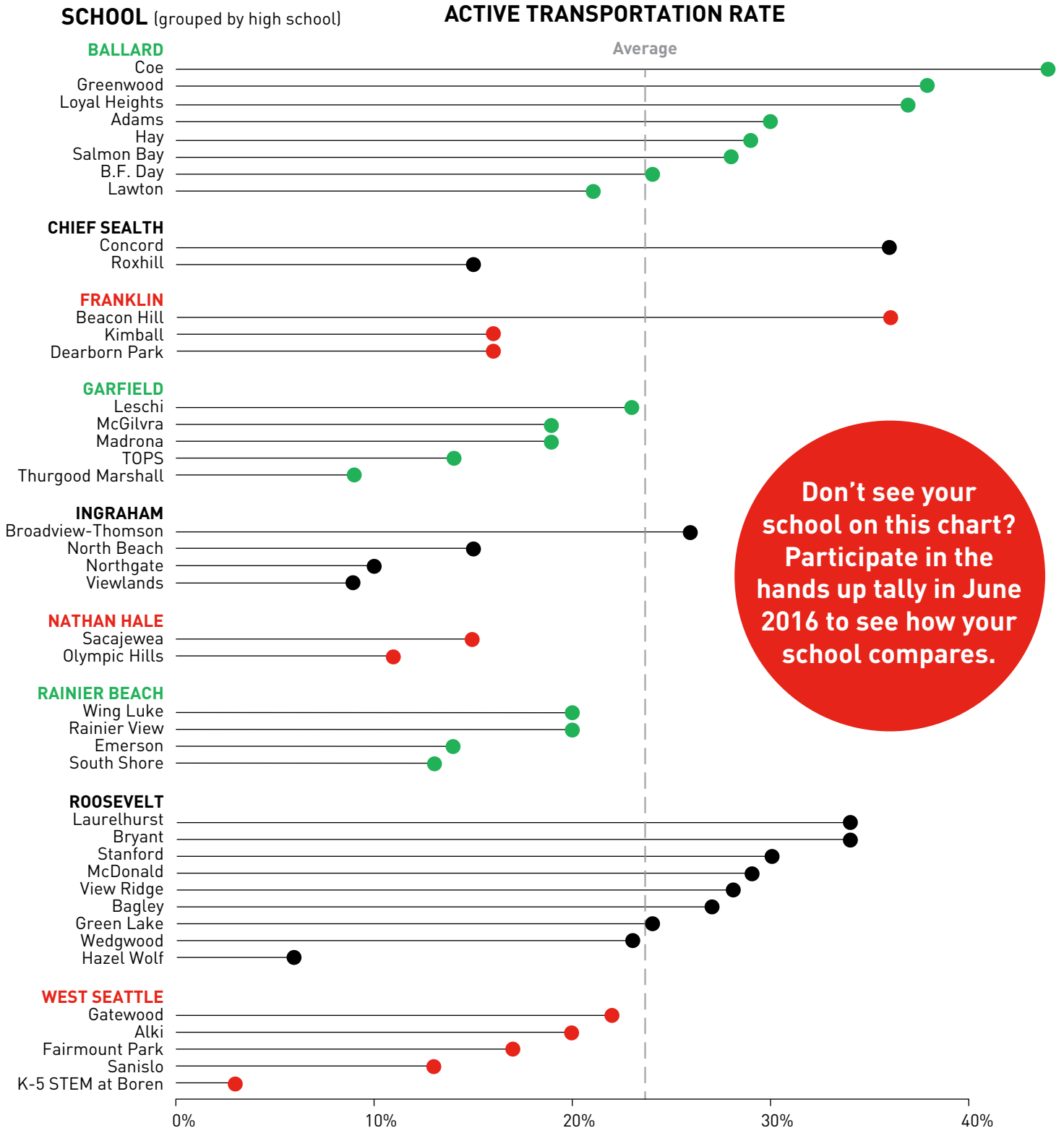
