ABOUT THE PROJECT

Madison Street BRT will improve east-west transit in Seattle by providing fast, frequent, reliable, and safe public transportation on Madison St between 1st Ave in downtown and Martin Luther King Jr Way in Madison Valley. The bus line will connect riders to bus and streetcar routes, ferry service, and Link light rail.

The Madison St corridor is busy, dense, and still growing. BRT combines the capacity and speed of light rail with the flexibility, lower cost, and simplicity of a bus system. With these improvements, King County Metro will operate service on Madison as Rapid Ride G.

The project will also make improvements to increase comfort, visibility, safety, legibility, and access for people walking and biking on the Madison St corridor.

YOU'RE INVITED TO COMMENT

SDOT completed its environmental review and is issuing a Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) to satisfy the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA). In lieu of a SEPA checklist, SDOT is adopting the Documented Categorical Exclusion (DCE) and supporting information that was completed to satisfy the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

The public is invited to comment on the DNS, beginning **February 15, 2018**. Comments must be postmarked or emailed by 5 PM on **March 1, 2018**.
