


# Combined Sewer System





# Project Schedule

- **February, 2018:** Initial Community Outreach
- **April/May, 2018:** SEPA Checklist Distribution
- **October, 2018:** Design Finalized & Contractor Selection Begins
- **January, 2019:** Construction Work Begins
- **September, 2019:** Construction Completion

- New pavement and ADA ramps along the alignment.
- Reduced the risk of pump station infrastructure failure.
- Better water quality by reducing combined sewer overflows.
- Improved safety conditions for SPU maintenance crews.
- Creation of a shoreline viewpoint and public access at the street end of W. Cramer Street, as per Seattle Municipal Code.
