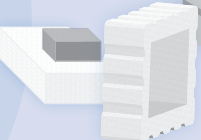
Recycle many small special items at once. 2'x2'x2' max size

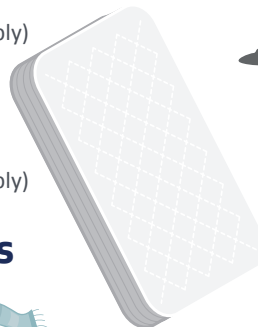

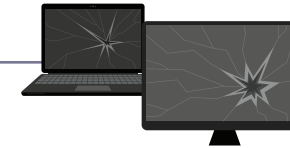

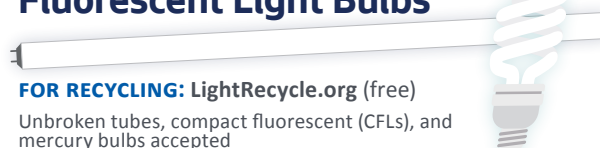
