# YOUTH ORCA PROGRAM



## Live too close to school to get an ORCA card?

If you are not eligible for an ORCA card from Seattle Public Schools, you may be eligible for the City of Seattle's new Youth ORCA program.

The ORCA cards distributed through this program will be valid for the entire school year, September 2016 through June 2017. Income eligibility for this program is consistent with many other programs including: SNAP, Free and Reduced Lunch, and ORCA LIFT. ORCA cards are valid on King County Metro, King County Water Taxi, Seattle Streetcar, Sound Transit, Community Transit, Pierce Transit, Kitsap Transit, and Everett Transit.

### HOW TO SIGN UP

To receive an ORCA card under this program, a student will need to fill out the application and get a parent or legal guardian's signature.

### WHERE TO SIGN UP

City staff will be hosting events at high schools and community centers in late August and early September to distribute cards. Bring the completed application to these events. Visit [www.seattle.gov/YouthORCA](http://www.seattle.gov/YouthORCA) for details.

## To be eligible for the program you need to:

- Be a high school student in Seattle Public Schools (grades 9-12);
- Not currently receive an ORCA card from Seattle Public Schools; and
- Live in a household that has an income under the amount listed in the table below.
