# No Licking!

Licking or chewing at the incision can cause infection.

Check the Incision

# Keep it Dry

Water affects surgical glue & opens the incision, causing infection.



What you see today is normal. Check twice a day for redness, swelling or discharge.

(The small, green tattoo indicates spayed or neutered.)

Inside rest gives the tissue time to heal & helps the incision stay closed.

(No running, jumping, or playing.)
