DISMISSAL ORDER

The Executive Director of the City of Seattle, Civil Service Commission hereby enters the following:

BACKGROUND

On July 29, 2014, Christopher Villa, (Appellant) filed an appeal with the Civil Service Commission regarding a Performance Management Memorandum issued by Electrical, Signs and Pressure Vessels Program Manager in the Department of Planning and Development (“the Department”).

The Commission assigned the appeal to CSC Hearing Officer, Donna Lurie and the hearing was conducted on September 30th and concluded on October 1st. Appellant represented himself and Felecia Caldwell, Administration Division Director, represented the Department.

On October 20, 2014, Donna Lurie, CSC Hearing Officer, issued the Findings and Decision in this matter determining the Department of Planning and Development did not violate Personnel Rule 1.5 when it issued the January 14, 2014 Performance Management memorandum to Christopher Villa.

At its November 19, 2014 monthly meeting the Commission reviewed the Findings and Decision and unanimously affirmed the decision of the Hearing Officer.

ORDER

The Civil Service Commission hereby dismisses this appeal with *prejudice*.
