DISMISSAL ORDER

The Executive Director of the City of Seattle, Civil Service Commission hereby enters the following:

BACKGROUND

By letter dated May 7, 2012, the Director of Seattle Public Utilities (“the Department”) imposed a one day disciplinary suspension on Lori Hamamoto (Appellant). On May 21, 2012, Appellant filed an appeal with the Civil Service Commission regarding the discipline taken by her employer.

Pursuant to SMC 4.04.250 (7), on May 30, 2012, the Commission delegated the appeal to the Office of the Hearing Examiner and the hearing was conducted on October 5, 2012. Appellant represented herself and the Department was represented by Charlene MacMillan-Davis, SPU Labor Relations Coordinator.

On October 18, 2012, Sue A. Tanner, Hearing Examiner, issued the Findings and Decision in this matter affirming the discipline imposed upon Appellant. Appellant filed a Petition for Review of the Presiding Officer’s Decision on October 26, 2012.

At its January 16, 2013 monthly meeting the Commission reviewed the Findings and Decision of the Hearing Examiner and Appellant’s Petition for Review and affirmed the decision to uphold the one day suspension of Appellant.

ORDER

The Civil Service Commission hereby dismisses this appeal with *prejudice*.
