BACKGROUND

By letter dated August 8, 2012, the Director of Seattle Public Utilities ("the Department") terminated the employment of Brian LaScala (Appellant). On August 27, 2012, Appellant filed an appeal with the Civil Service Commission regarding the discipline taken by his employer.

Pursuant to SMC 4.04.250 (7), on August 28, 2012, the Commission delegated the appeal to the Office of the Hearing Examiner and the hearing was conducted on October 30, 2012. Appellant represented himself and the Department was represented by Nancy Cole, SPU Labor Relations Coordinator.

On November 5, 2012, Sue A. Tanner, Hearing Examiner, issued the Findings and Decision in this matter affirming the discipline imposed upon Appellant.

At its January 16, 2013 monthly meeting the Commission reviewed the Findings and Decision of the Hearing Examiner and affirmed the decision to uphold the termination of Appellant's employment.

ORDER

The Civil Service Commission hereby dismisses this appeal with prejudice.
