A scheduling order for the first prehearing conference in this matter was served on the parties for Thursday, May 19, at 10:00 a.m. The order stated, "Participation of the parties and their representatives is required at this proceeding, and the appeal will be dismissed if the appellant does not appeal or contact the Executive Director in advance to reschedule." On Wednesday, May 18, the appellant notified the Executive Director by email that she did not wish to proceed with the matter now that she was separated from City employment, and she would not attend the prehearing conference.

On May 19, 2022, Executive Director Scheele emailed back to acknowledge the Appellant's intent not to proceed with the appeal and requested that she file a formal withdrawal of appeal. She also cancelled the prehearing conference based on the Appellant's expressed intent that she was withdrawing her appeal. Two weeks have lapsed since that correspondence and cancellation of the prehearing conference. The Appellant has not filed a formal notice of appeal, nor has she requested to reschedule the prehearing conference or to proceed with her appeal. CSC Rule 5.22 provides "[a]n appellant's request to withdraw shall be granted as a matter of right and the appeal shall be dismissed."
