- December 16, 2020-Special Meeting: The Commission reviewed the minutes of the December 16, 2020 Special Meeting. Commissioner Davis moved to accept the minutes as written. Commissioner Wideman-Williams seconded the motion.

- December 16, 2020-Joint Meeting: The Commission reviewed the minutes of the

4. CASE STATUS REPORT/APPEALS UPDATE

- **Gina Kim v. Seattle Public Utilities, CSC No. 20-07-013:** Ms. Scheele reported Ms. Kim is appealing her decision to dismiss her appeal for lack of jurisdiction. The matter will be on the February meeting agenda.
- Robert Smith v. Department of Finance and Administrative Services: The second prehearing will take place on January 11. The hearing is scheduled in March.

2. CSC ADMINISTRATION

- 2021 Chair: Commissioner Davis moved to nominate commission chair Bonfrisco to serve a second term as the CSC Chair. Commission Chair Bonfrisco accepted the nomination. Commissioner Wideman-Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- **2021 Meeting Dates:** The commission agreed to hold it 2021 meetings on the third Monday at 2:00 pm.

3. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

- Departmental Work Update: Employee Election: Ms. Scheele reported that the election results were certified in January and Commissioner Amy Bonfrisco was reelected to serve a second term as the employee elected commissioner. Planning Retreat: The commission agreed to hold a planning retreat on April 19, 2021. The commission will look at its outreach to city employees, brainstorm ideas on accessibility and other matters.
 Disciplinary Hearings: Ms. Scheele reported the staff is currently working on disciplinary hearings for CSC and PSCSC.
- **Budget Update** Ms. Scheele reported there could be a possible carryover of 2020 funds to the 2021 budget. BIP's would be due for 2021 and CIV would possibly have a

supplemental for salary adjustment due to the reclassification of staff positions.


