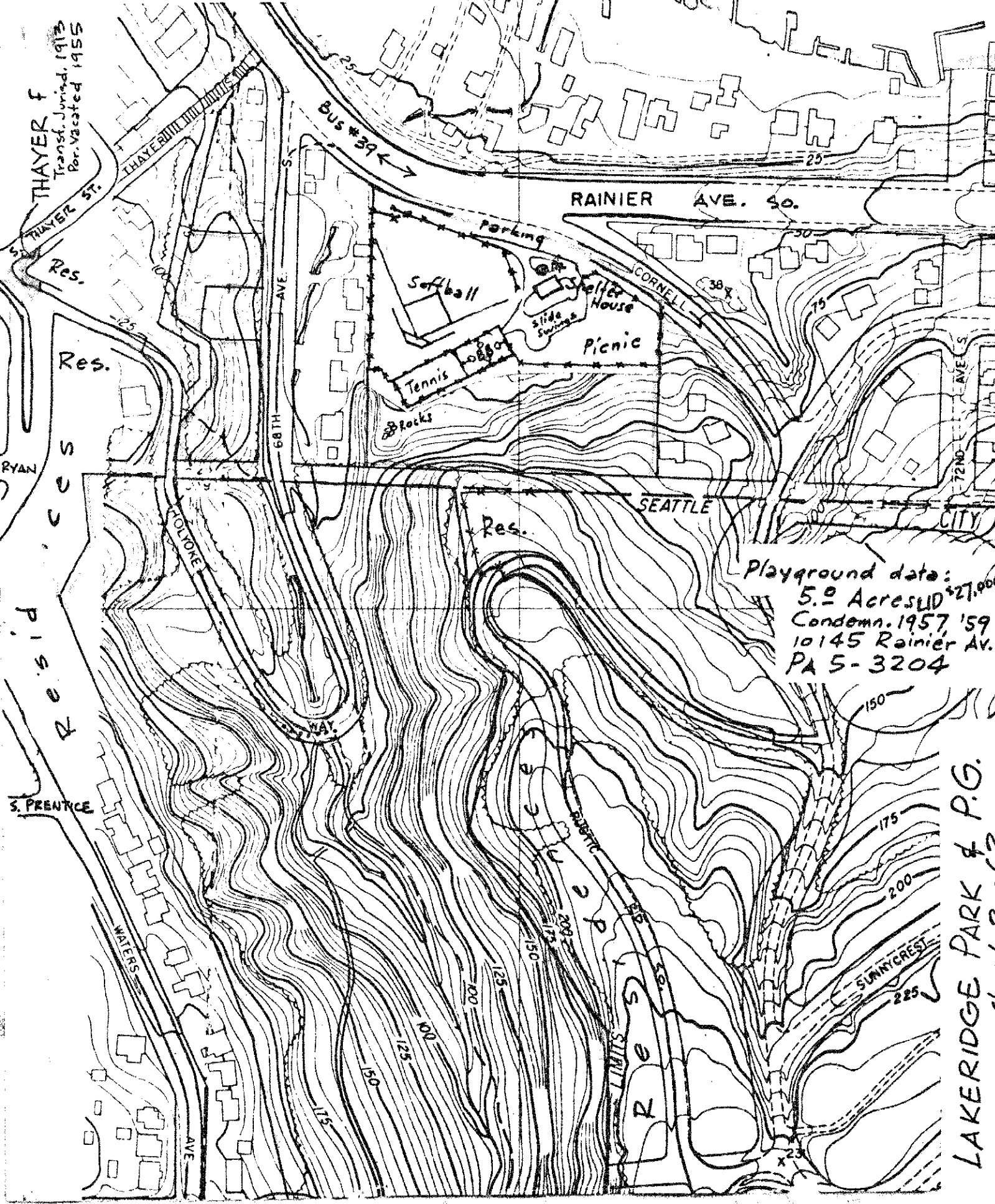


Rainier Av. named for mountain (named by Capt. Vancouver for Adm. Peter Rainier.
