Our section regularly advises the Mayor's Office, City Council, City boards and commissions, and City departments on matters that advance their policy interests.

The extern would perform legal research, draft memoranda, and assist with other tasks as needed. Applicants should have excellent research and writing capabilities and be able to work well (and amiably) under deadline pressure. Experience with and interest in City government matters is a plus.

This is an **unpaid** position, but we are happy to work with your law school so that you may obtain externship credit. This position is open until filled.
