This 16-member board, appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Seattle City Council, advises Seattle Center staff, the Mayor, and City Council on policies affecting Seattle Center's operations and redevelopment. The Commission also provides ongoing assessments of department performance, plans, and policies to Seattle Center staff, the Mayor, and City Council. The Seattle Center Advisory Commission meets on the first Thursday of each month, from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m., at Seattle Center. While virtual attendance is available, in-person participation is preferred, and a commitment to regular attendance is essential. Commissioners will also have the opportunity to engage in a variety of events and activities at Seattle Center throughout the year.
