Upcoming Conversations on Police Accountability and Public Safety

The Seattle Community Police Commission (CPC) is partnering with Rainier Avenue Radio and the Urban League of Metropolitan Seattle to host a Police Accountability Series on key issues impacting policing and public safety in Seattle.

The first three events in the series will be **radio interviews airing live on Rainier Avenue Radio**, hosted by Tony B and featuring CPC Executive Director Eci Ameh, CPC Commissioners, and community voices. The series will conclude with a community **Town Hall on Police Accountability at the Columbia City Theater**, which will be **free and open to the public**.

Police Accountability Series Schedule:

- **September 15 (5–6 PM)** – The Consent Decree: Its impact on policing in Seattle
- **September 25 (5–6 PM)** – The Chronic Nuisance Law and its effects on communities
- **September 30 (5–6 PM)** – Police Surveillance Technology and public safety concerns
- **October 21 (6–8 PM, Columbia City Theater)** – Police Accountability Town Hall, free and open to the public, also broadcast live on Rainier Avenue Radio

“This series creates a vital opportunity for dialogue,” said Eci Ameh, Executive Director of the Community Police Commission. “I’m excited for what this partnership can do to engage communities and increase civic participation.”
