Mr. Tsimerman:

After we met on July 24th I reviewed your letter and complaint dated July 22, 2015; City's Rules regarding use of City facilities; the June 2015 Washington Supreme Court decision, State of Washington v. E.J.J., which addressed use of profanity and criminal prosecution; and, the City of Seattle Legislative Department procedures regarding exclusions and appeals.

As you know, the Seattle Ethics and Elections Commission has jurisdiction over several City codes. None of the issues you raised in our meeting or in your July 22nd complaint fall under the Commission's jurisdiction. We cannot address your concerns regarding the possible denial of your First Amendment rights under the United States and Washington State Constitutions; or investigate possible criminal activity under RCW 42.20 Misconduct of Public Officers; prosecute fraud by City contractors; or, address the possible illegality of the City's appeal process regarding exclusion orders and trespass charges.

You may wish to contact the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), an organization that addresses First Amendment issues (206-624-2184), or contact local legal clinics located at areas law schools to discuss the propriety and possible challenge to the rules on which your exclusion is based.
