### **How to Contact Us**

The Seattle Municipal Tower is closed to the public until at least early July, but the Democracy Voucher staff will be in the office regularly. # **Electronic Document Signing**

If you are using an electronic signing system for the Candidate Qualifying form, ensure the signature area requires the "draw" option. Also, we recommend the signer use their smart phone/pad in a horizontal position and draw with their finger or a stylus. If the signer uses the mouse or touchpad on a computer, the signature might not match their voter registration signature.

# **Voucher Artwork**


PDFs of the voucher packet artwork is attached for your use. We can provide the design files upon request.
